DIPLOMA PREP COURSES

Diploma Exams are approaching quickly. There are several review sessions available to grade 12 students. The first is Rock the Diploma. This is a three day 15 hour review session in person at Lindsay Thurber in Red Deer. The cost for this is \$135 per course. The second is a program called Excelerator. This review is provided online and is around 20 hours. The cost is \$100 per course. Chinook's Edge School Division will reimburse students \$50 per course. If your child signs up for either option please let Ms. Ray know so she can send your information to the division office for a reimbursement.
